1 Hardware Setup

1.1 Hardware Included

- Dell Optiplex desktop PC with power cord.
- HDMI cable
- One monitor, including power cord and VGA cable
- Wireless keyboard and mouse combination
- Antenna (for WIFI wireless connection)
- <u>If needed:</u> Display adapter to connect a monitor. Only for monitors that do not have an HDMI port compatible with the laptop's HDMI port.

1.2 Set up the PC


1. Connect the keyboard and mouse to the USB ports on the back of the PC.





2. Connect to your home network using one of the following methods:

If your connection is	Then	
Wired	Connect an Ethernet cable to the PC and modem.	
Wireless	Connect the antenna to the round gold port.	



3. Connect the power cord to the transformer and plug it into an electrical outlet.





4. Connect the round end of the power cord to the back of the PC.





1.3 Set up the Monitor(s)

- 1. Remove the monitor from the box and assemble the stand per the included instructions.
- 2. Connect the power cable included with the monitor to the power port on the back of the monitor:

The back of your monitor should look similar to this one. The power connector for the monitor is circled below.



3. Connect the female end (circled below) of the power cable to the monitor.




4. Plug the other end of the power cable into an electrical outlet.



1.4 Connecting a Monitor to the PC

1. Connect one end of the HDMI cable OR display port cable to the back of the monitor.



2. Connect the other end to either HDMI or display port on the back of the PC.



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2 Set Up Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) on your Mobile Device

Purpose: The Symantec[™] VIP Two-Factor Authentication Service is a comprehensive solution, providing increased security for WellStar Health System (WHS) computer applications and better protection for end users who are interacting online against identity theft.

2.1 Obtain a Symantec VIP Access Mobile App Credential

- 1. From your mobile device, connect to WIFI.
- 2. Visit the mobile app store for your device (see table below).
- 3. Search for the **VIP Access** app **and** download to install the app to your device.

Apple (iPhone, iPad, or iPod Touch)	Apple App Store	Requires iOS 7.0 or later
Android	Google Play Store	Requires Android 4.0 and up

- 4. Tap Open to launch the application.
- 5. If you are prompted to allow notifications tap **Allow**.

2.2 Register your Symantec VIP Access App and Device

- 1. From a separate web browser, go to the *Symantec VIP Registration Form:* <u>https://register2FA.wellstar.org</u>
- 2. Follow the instructions on the form, entering the requested information.
- 3. Tap Submit at the bottom.



You will receive an email confirmation once your registration is complete. Please allow up to 24 hours for your registration to be processed.

2.3 Test your Two-Factor Authentication


- 1. Open a browser on any device and navigate to <u>https://staff.wellstar.org</u>.



3 Connect to Wellstar's Virtual Private Network (VPN)

1. Turn on the PC.



2. Press Ctrl-Alt-Del keys simultaneously.

You are not required to sign into GlobalProtect again after Windows starts. GlobalProtect uses your Windows credentials to sign in, so you just need to verify the login on your mobile device (step 7 above).



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
