

Adding a Wellstar Account to Microsoft Authenticator

Purpose: This procedure is for those who already have Authenticator installed on a mobile device and have a non-Wellstar account registered to it.



Non-Wellstar Authenticator accounts are unaffected by adding a Wellstar account.

Requirements: • You need two separate devices to complete this procedure:

- Computer (personal or work)
- The mobile device (such as a smartphone or tablet) that has Microsoft Authenticator installed
